1 Name of Instrument [see Note 1]

This Instrument is the *Charter of the United Nations (UN Sanction Enforcement Law) Declaration 2008*.

2 Commencement [see Note 1]

This Instrument commences immediately after the commencement of Schedule 1 to the *International Trade Integrity Act 2007*.

3 UN sanction enforcement laws

For subsection 2B (1) of the *Charter of the United Nations Act 1945*, each provision mentioned in an item in Schedule 1, being a provision of a law of the Commonwealth mentioned in that item, is specified as a UN sanction enforcement law.
